

Two Wallace Fountains Adapted for Multiple Users

Located in the pedestrian esplanade near the Metro station, Pont de Neuilly, this Wallace Fountain has been modified with three spigots. Three people at a time can easily fill their water bottles, wash hands or splash water on a hot day. The spigots also save drinking water and prevent corrosion of the caryatids and upper half of the fountain.

The other Wallace Fountain in Neuilly-sur-Seine is located in the lovely Square de l'eau d'Albienne. The square was redeveloped in 2022 and its fountain, originally installed in 1985, was reinstalled and adapted with spigots. This fountain is supplied in part by water from the Albienne aquifer, which is drawn from 600 to 800 meters below ground and has been filtered for a long time between the rocks, making it extremely rich in minerals. The city of Neuilly-sur-Seine distributes this water, mixed with potable water, through its general water supply network.
