

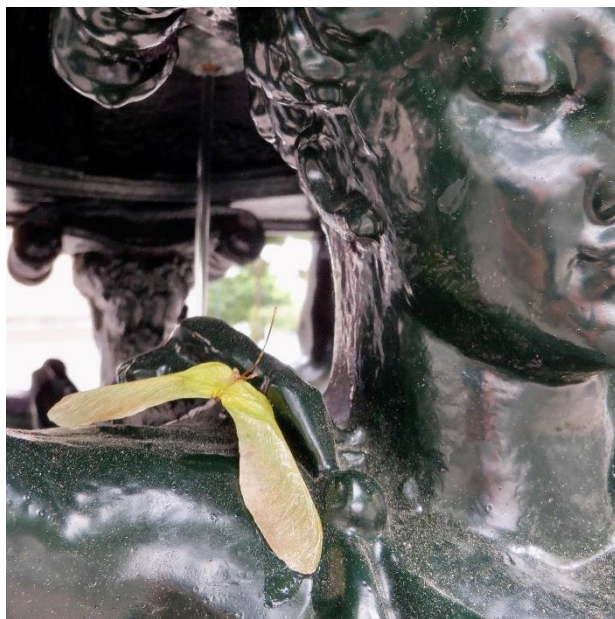
A Wallace Fountain at Noisy-le-Grand

This Wallace fountain stands across the street from the old town hall, which was bought by the municipality from the Desvignes family in 1841 to establish a municipal premises and a school. The building was used from 1843 to 1926, accommodating two teachers, the Municipal Council Chamber and a secretariat. The Wallace fountain appeared on the street sometime after 1971.
